ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR 2011

Indian Rural Development Association has its aim in charitable services to the needy people. In our area of service, we come across across categories of people who were in need of our service and these categories are as follows ; 1) Forward class (FC), 2) Backward Class (BC), 3) Most Back Ward Class (MBC), 4) Other Back Ward Class (OBC), 5) Schedule Castes (SC) 6) Scheduled Tribes (ST). Our assessment enlighten us to find special category of people among all of these section is people living below poverty line (BPL). This is in existence from all the categories, who are in need of help / support / encouragement and upliftment in every walks of life to reach the main stream. Thus we have decided to conduct services useful to them.

HIGHLIGHTS

In our pathway we find suitable and as over all development activities as follows :



MEDICAL : As usual and as in practice the activities on medical conducted. By spending are Rs.53,856/- we have as many as handicapped persons who are in need of medical aid and we found the desiring people who are badly in need of aid, and support of all the staff and trust members and well wisher the medical aid was given these handicapped persons. One beneficiaries are happy which cannot be measured.

General Medical Camps were also conducted by spending Rs. 33,976/- in the year 2011. The programme spread to two days in two different months where in maximum beneficiares are listed out. We found both the doctors who participated in the camps and the beneficiary poor people are happy which cannot be measured, and they insist for continuous camps. We are blessed to have more camps in future.

AIDS AWARENESS PROGRAMME :

Medical Awareness combined with social awareness is yet another important activity suggested by the trust. The fast moving AIDS hazard needs immediate attention and



rectification in war foot. People decides their life with love and affection. In their pathway they come across certain deviations, but vulnerable among these deviations like AIDS are visible only when affected. Though this is affected by few our Government aims at curbing the path through various measures. We take part in support of these measures and have awareness programme to start with. The trust dedicates itself as commitment to the safety of people our service area to educate the people on the seriousness of the decease and to be

careful. On their scholastic life and to lead their life with love and affection with any deviation like AIDS. Our Trust by spending Rs. 66,782/- in the year 2011 had various education / awareness programmes on AIDS. The participants are supplied with informative pamphlets, announcement through loudspeakers, visible notes and guide ness through banners and exhibits.

FORMAL EDUCATION AND SUPPORT

The children and youths of the area of our service needs our help and support. The poor people and their backwardness needs support from organization like us. Being the

service oriented organization our trust aims at helping the needy to prosecute their education and supportive materials. In this way I the year 2011, we spent an amount of Rs. 1,21,315/- for the supply of School Uniforms, Note Books and other The Trust also spent Teaching Aids. Rs.36,878/- being the cost of Educational books for their studies. The beneficiaries are kind enough to accept our gesture and we are able to taste the response of studies without any disturbance. As they required, we conduct some periodical verification by meeting them and review the same and to streamline their straight



steps from any possible deviations. Thus they are blessed with proper education. Shortly the management decided to establish coaching centers to assist their educational career, which is a need of the day.

WOMEN DEVELOPMENT :



Our Trust spares attention on the development empowerment of women. Protracted discussions were made by the members on the studies done in our jurisdictional area of service, where in the low level living condition of women and their dependent children. The delapalated service condition and low earnings of each of them makes the trust members to be alert to have some schematic programmes exclusively for the improvement, socially, economically.

WOMEN TRAINING/ COUNSELLING PROGRAMME :

The basic needs are sorted out offer studies and our Trust decided to have awareness, educational and training programmes to the women. Our Trust felt that the monetary situation were bad and it was deteriorated condition due to lack of knowledge. Hence, they were given technical knowledge and usage of machineries to utilize in service for their earnings. An amount of Rs. 82,160/- were spent on this training. They are brought to the knowledge that they are eligible for improvement. As a moral support these poor women and children are distributed with DRESS, DRESS MATERIALS AND FOOD PROVISIONS are supplied to them. By that, we found their were diversion in their ill=thinking and feeling of helplessness. For which we have spent Rs. 58,142/- formally. We got the response they are happy and follow the guidance and practice through the trainings for their earnings to support themselves. On their instance, these women are put on <u>ENTERPRENEUR TRAINING</u> training to highlight them on the manufacturing, knowledge on raw materials and their use, calling them on manufacturing of the products and knowledge on earnings and savings.

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME :

Is yet another activity earmarked for women. The women are not isolated from human life. They are eligible for awareness on whatever available in this world under the sun. This alertness. thev are toughs with understanding, usefulness of education and follow-up of self and children, if possible to other general public. In a nutshell, they are eligible for awareness on legal facilities and thus we have a successful programe of legal awareness and women empowerment was conducted with an allotted budget of Rs. 55,782/- in the year 211. Our trust feels that it is a blessed programme of us has maximum beneficiaries.



GENERAL :

Our trust which is aiming at introducing around development of people in our area, has not limited its activities only with above areas. has concentration It on Environment Awareness and spent Rs.41,348/- Through which we have educated the people on the pollution and reasons for the same. Sanitation of self, family and her living locality. The trust also felt necessary that educated mass and up-coming children through their education are also required support, thus the Trust conducted SELFhas



EMPLOYMENT PROGRAMME, at the cost of Rs.26,378/- and Computer Education Programme at a cost of Rs.54,100/- for the year 2011. The beneficiaries are good in size and response in increasing for which our Trust is ready to dedicate its service.

DEVELOPMENT TRAINING FOR SCHEDULED CASTE



Our Trust is alert in assessing the people, where in the social status of the Scheduled Caste / Tribe / Backward / Minorities and Women are not up to the man. Hence, it was decided to have development Training Programme. Thus, only few people are gathered in our area and to start with only Scheduled Caste people were given training for their development financially, socially and educational and awareness on social movement. In our intention of collecting statistics on the other people which is in programs and in final stage will be given sufficient activities and programmes equal to others. We hope that our aim of doing justices to the human being will also be extended to these down trodden and helpless backward people. Wherein our Trust and supporters are going to be joined in active participation for their benefit a phased manner.

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ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR 2013.

Indian Rural Development Association ® in its pathway of service to humanity steps forward with visions developmental activities in a pleased manner spread to one year since its inception in Chidambaram District of Tamil Nadu. Unlike every year in the year 2013 also the Charitable Trust entertained many activities as its programme for progress. The people of CHIDAMBARAM in particular and Cuddalore Dist in general deserves support and encouragement in various aspects. In its way back, the Trust measured to extend its Service in the year 2013 also, though certain schemes and programmes are repeated every year, the Trust keep on reporting the New Programmes every year with a watch to give preference to requirements. The activities as estimated for the year 2013 was done to the tune of Rs. 3,36,951-00 on women welfare activities, Rs. 7,45,602-00 on Health activities, Rs. 3,51,044 on Youth Welfare, Rs. 5,80,846 on poor and aged welfare



Rs. 33,620. On Forest are environmental activities are to be highlighted at present.

(1) WOMEN WELFARE ACTIVITIES :

In the location where our activities are entertained is CUDDALORE District in General and

CHIDAMBARAM Taluk in Particular. The life of women especially uneducated, drop outs, married youngsters and even the girls who are prosecuting their education are in need of

encouragement at every stage. As a token of our gesture to encourage them, we spent an estimated amount of Rs. 10,800 on Free Tailoring Machine distribution to the poors who are trained by ourselves Rs. 64,840 on women councelling and Training Rs. 94,861 on self-helping group and awareness, Rs. 61,210 on Income generating Programme of Beautician Training.



There are many more identified for Programme implementation in the near future.

(2) HEALTH WELFARE AND AWARENESS : The Health Sector is yet another area of coverage. This needs encouragement in almost all locations of Cuddalore but our services are limited to allotted funds due to paucity of Funds. However, for the year 2013, an amount of Rs. 52,146 is spent on Medical Aid to Handicapped, Rs. 33,194 on Health Awareness, Rs. 2,28,244 on Medical Camp and distribution of Free Medicines. Rs. 4,288 on Free Medical expenses Rs. 71,360 on Aids Awareness, Rs. 61,358 on Family Planning Programme, Rs. 2,28,244 on Free Distribution of Medicines Eye / Dental and General Medicines, Rs. 56,768 on Blood Donation Camps, many more Awareness and



relief Camps are estimated for near future.

(3) Y O U T H EMPOWERMENT:

The youths of the Area of our service is another sector needs attention of NGOs, like us. Though they are enjoying the support of self, and G o v e r n m e n t , i n implementing the needgy

programmes, the NGO's sector support is very much in need. Our Trust identified certain

areas of activities for implementation and started encouraging these helpless youths limited to estimated funds. In this spear Rs. 33,854 is spent on Vocational Training Programme, Rs. 41,380 on self employment schemes Rs. 41,420, on distribution of Free Sports materials Rs. 63,820 on Free Computer Training, Rs. 66,700 on financial aid



to poors students, Rs. 63,820 on Free distribution of Books & Note books & shoes. As the sector has vast area of encouragement, we are able to cover limited funds but will sorted out with special programmes in future.

4) **POOR AND SENIOR CITIZENS**: Though the aged and the poor are very much eager to encouragements by NGO's like us, our Trust steps forward to shoulder for

encouragement with schematic programmes. But in the year the allotted limited funds are supported us to do certain service Rs. 1,84,240 is spent on distribution of Nutritious food to poor people and children Rs. 76,344 on Food Provisions and Dress to the poor Rs. 1,24,362 spent on Aid to the Aged Rs. 1,32,100 on distribution of Free Uniforms, Books



and Pens to them. There are more people and children are estimated for inclusion in the Programme the near future with more funds allotted.

(5) FOREST AND ENVIRONMENT : The nature needs growth free from pollution in all. Though the silence of nature with climate change, it was the duly of human mass to



understand the position of nature who fails to function as usual, but with changes. This needs control by human in their activities, habits and practice. The vulnerable Condition was understood by our Trust, our activities extended attention on stoppage of pollution in all to keep the environment, ecology by practicing pollution free activities. As such Rs. 18,500/- spent on free plantation of

trees, and Rs. 15,120 on environment and awareness camps. This needs more encouragements and attention, more and more programmes are on cards for future.

FREE MEDICAL AID TO POOR

i)Medical Campus



The most important sector that an NGO should cover is health awareness and welfare programme. Around 3 children out of every 50 children faces tongue-lip tie problem. An awareness program and medical aid was conducted at Cuddalore, Sidhambaram , Seerkali in 2014. Around 50 people joined their hands together to head this camp. More than 105 people were benefited out of it. We spent for this medical camp. An increase in the fund expected in future years that would take up this event a successful one.

ii)ARTIFICAL LIMB PLACEMENT

Our trust which aimed in the development of poor and needy people, has taken a new attempt to recover the limb of the handicap people. Artificial limbs were placed for the people who has loosen the limbs in accidents and other issues. It was held in Cuddalore. Around 79 people were benefitted out of this camp. The beauty of the camp is that the specialised doctors were welcomed and were asked to give awareness on artificial limbs, exercises to be done regularly for the handicap people. Though we had limited fund we made this a great jorney.

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the grateful reform that is required in India to develop our nation is education. The trust that focus the education not only feeds Today's India and tomorrow's India. Our trust which has education as its core motto, free books and uniform were distributed to the pillars



of India (students). In order to encourage the students, firing the notch would become the notch for the

tomorrow's India. Being an NGO,though we couldn't meet up with required financial support, we ended uo this event with a great successful. Each student is given with required with 10 notes and required books as well as a set of uniform were distributed.

v)LIBRARY



As the continuity to the distribution of books and notes to the budding rural area students, a great attempt was put

forth to improve the personality, general knowledge and softskill of the young pillars. Library was built. 123 novel books, 345 epic books, 700 general knowledge books, 1207 science books and 568 other books were brought and set up the library. We used to bring out this library. This attempt reserved the "highlight" of our trust in 2014 which will be replaced in the upcoming years. To highlight the proverb "Books build dreams, dreams construct inspiration, inspiration is implemented in the society" the counts of the books are increased to the best of our level.

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The survey on the "Drawback of the growth of our Nation" made us focus on the agriculture. The backbones (villages) are gradually vanishing due to lack of proper agricultural tools, equipment, and other basic needs for farming. Thus we put forth our attention towards agriculture to groom our nation. The

FLOOD RECOVERY TEAM

Health, agriculture, women empowerment, Awareness about diseases, Education, etc all sectors plays a vital role in every organisation. Out of all, timely help for the needy and victim is the crucial part of every NGO. During the flood in the month November we formed a



team of 178 member and collected 37 required items for the people and distributed all materials including

2 kg of rice to each person. Totally 23675 were paid off. Our team reached out MGR Nagar, Ponneri, Kattur, Thirupalaivanam and



served there. Food packets were distributed at the time of flood thrice a day and we continued our serve till the flood drained out. This remarked the healthy approach of our organization.

MEDICAL CAMP

One of the paramount need which every NGO has to concentrate is Medicinal Sector. A gratifying NGO has to focus on the health welfare and an awareness



program has to be conducted atleast thrice a year. We conducted a medical camp at MGR Nagar, Ponneri, Kattur,

Thirupalaivanam during Flood. We uconsumed for the medicines and used up for the purchase of basic needs to the people. 25673 people were given medical check-up and got doctor advice.

ANNADHAN

As an NGO, to put our passion into action and become a Champion for the Poor, the best gift to the needy is food donation. Thus, our NGO has brought out this yojana. In this scheme 456 people were provided with meals. We made this event a successful one. The funds allocated for annadhan will be increased in upcoming years. And we aimed to benefit more than 11akh poor people in the queue.

MEDICAL SUPPORT

Our Health Camps is one a special initiative to provide healthcare services to meet the immediate health care needs of the marginalized community in remote rural areas and slums through standalone camps. Customized health camps are organized extensively across the region of Cuddalore, Chidambaram, etc offering comprehensive health services – curative, preventive, promotive and referral, to a large number of people in selected intervention areas.

i) BLOOD CAMP

Blood donation is one of the most significant contribution that a person can make towards the society. It is not harmful for an adult person to donate blood. It is a healthy gesture. This camp was formulated by 6-member team. Blood check-up was done for every individual. Importance of blood was explained in the camp. It was a great success which resulted many people to come forward to denote blood.

EDUCATIONAL REFORM



If we do not reform our education system, we will be letting down future generations of pupils. reform is not only necessary, it is essential if we

are to ensure that pupils are equipped with the knowledge and skills for the twenty-first century. Putting this into concern, we NGO has taken up a step to distribute books and educate the current technology to the rural area students.

i) NOTEBOOK DISTRIBUTION

Majority of India still lives in villages and so the topic of rural education in India is of utmost importance. A survey named called the Annual Status of Education



Report (ASER), shows that even though the number of rural students attending schools is rising but more than half of the students

in fifth grade are unable to read a second grade text book this is due to lack of proper text books and learning material in the schools. Thus we provide quality and branded books to the student in order to improve the knowledge of them. This event was organised by a group of 16 members and is used to enhance the life of the students.

ii) COMPUTER TRAINING
